The program is developmentally appropriate for beginning readers and also offers fast and highly effective intervention for children of all levels who have fallen behind in their reading and spelling.

Sounds~Write Training

The four-day practical and intensive course offers an instructional method that is structured, cumulative, sequential and explicit; all of which are strongly recommended for the effective teaching of children to read and spell.

An emphasis is placed on providing practice that is grounded in the knowledge, skills and understandings students need to acquire in order to be successful.

Training is either provided face-to-face over four days or in an online format.

Online training option now available!

The online practitioner course runs for six weeks (with four weeks of content) and will be monitored by experienced Sounds~Write trainers.

Participants receive the same materials and information as the face-to-face workshop option, with additional videos and reflections that can be reviewed throughout the month. You will also be part of a group that progresses together and stays in touch via virtual community forums which are supported and facilitated by Sounds~Write trainers.
